TRAVEL:

BUSES

The **MANHATTAN COUNTRY SCHOOL** at 7 East 96th Street will be the departure site for our chartered buses from Manhattan on opening morning. The campers on the buses will be supervised by our staff. Fare is \$125.00 one way. (More information on this will follow.)

AUTOS

Families who accompany their children to Treetops are invited to arrive between 1:30 and 4:00 p.m. Parents will have an opportunity to meet counselors, to visit the camper's summer tent-home and to become familiar with our site.

AIR

Transcontinental arrivals will be met at Albany, NY Airport. Fare is \$90.00 one way.

HEALTH FORMS:

Please **return prior to June 1st** the completed Health Form and Medical Release pink cards.

It is **MANDATORY** that the Health and Medication Forms be completed in full -- with a complete **IMMUNIZATION HISTORY**, examining **PHYSICIAN'S SIGNATURE** and **PARENT'S SIGNATURE**.

Our Treetops Registered Nurses will insure the health and safety of our summer community. We shall contact you by telephone if there is an emergency concerning your camper. All medications including vitamins, inhalers, medicated creams and non prescription medications must be kept in the nurse's office and require a doctor's signed order for administration.

If there is need for medical, dental or hospital care during our Camp season, statements from the doctors or hospitals will be directed to you for payment and/or processing by your insurance company. Please be sure to complete the health insurance information to assure that any medical claims are billed to your insurance - if there is incomplete information the medical center will send the bill directly to you.

TUITION:

FULL TUITION IS DUE MAY 15, 2010 in our business office. Bills will be mailed out mid-April. A finance charge of 1 1/2% per month will be levied on accounts more than 30 days past due. Statements of account are rendered monthly; billing for travel and incidentals will be done during the summer. **Campers with unpaid tuition will not be admitted to Treetops opening day.**

CLOTHING/ EQUIPMENT:

We request that extra items be kept to a minimum.
